

SOLID-COLOR UNIFORM GUIDELINES FOR THE 2016 SEASON

The solid-color uniform rule **will not** be enforced in the Middle School and Junior High programs at all levels. The primary reason is because of the budget factor of schools having to replace uniforms and the fact that many schools don't even use the libero.

The solid-color uniform rule **will not** be enforced in the High School programs at the JV, C and 9th grade levels for the same reason as above.

The solid-color uniform rule **will not** be enforced in the High School varsity programs for pre-season matches including jamborees and invitational tournaments as in many instances the format emphasizes the honor system for subs and liberos to keep the tournament on schedule.

The solid-color uniform rule **will be** enforced in the High School programs at the Varsity level for all regular season league matches and post-season play. Concerns regarding the legality of uniforms should be resolved during the pre-season.

Schools may request an interpretation concerning the legality of uniforms by sending photos of the front, back and sides of the libero jersey and regular player jersey. Measurements of the width of color going along the seams will also be needed. Officials are not allowed to take photos under any circumstances.
